IB SCHOLARSHIP

Concordia College recognizes the academic rigor of the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma program as outstanding preparation for study at Concordia. The balanced IB curriculum aligns closely with the liberal arts credo of challenging students to think deeply, while developing the ability to communicate persuasively.

Concordia's IB Scholarship will be awarded to every IB student who is accepted to Concordia College. A student with an IB Diploma who achieved 30 or more points will receive an IB Scholarship of \$5,000 per year, and a student with an IB Certificate or IB Diploma with 24 to 29 points will receive an IB Scholarship of \$2,500 per year.

Students completing the IB program at the time they are accepted will be awarded a tentative IB Scholarship based on their expected results. Once official IB results are provided, the IB Scholarship amount will be finalized.

Concordia's IB recognition policy is considered exemplary by IBO. If a student has the IB Diploma with 30 or more points, the student will receive 24 transfer credits and begin studies with sophomore standing. A student with this result can complete a bachelor's degree in three years if he or she takes a full load of courses each semester.

Concordia's IB Scholarship may be combined with the International Student Scholarship, or may be replaced by a higher amount if you are eligible for U.S. federal financial aid.

HL classes will be considered first, and then SL classes will be accepted to reach 24 credits.

If students earn a certificate or score below 30 total points, only HL classes will be considered for transfer.

No classes with a score under 4 will be considered for transfer.
